Duties and Responsibilities:

- Work mainly on a project basis. Projects may be product design related, process improvement related, or customer/industry support related.
- Be able to lead projects from concept to completion, combining and encouraging the various cross-functional personnel required to complete the goals.
- Be able to work well with fellow employees, contribute in multiple scenarios (sometimes with overlapping schedules), and take direction when part of a team but not the leader.
- Work closely with product managers, manufacturing personnel, and/or outside suppliers to analyze parts and assemblies for strength and reliability, manufacturability, material costs, and customer acceptance (aesthetics, safety, function, etc.).
- Maintain liaison with internal (manufacturing, sales, service, and production control) as well as external (owner/operator, dealer, supplier) customers to best coordinate and fulfill required activities in assigned projects.
- Periodic jobsite or vendor visits and trade show attendance may be required for information gathering and customer/supplier contact.
- Ability and experience in creation of all documentation needed to produce and sell the product. This includes drawings, bill of materials (BOM), specifications sheets, and Engineering Change Notices (ECN) with an emphasis on accuracy, integrity, and timely production of the information.
- Maintain (in a neat and organized format) the product folder(s) on the company's N: drive that contain all of the information related to each of the projects led.

- Adherence to all internal standards and regulations (ISO procedures, drafting standards, etc.)
- Perform additional duties as assigned or required.
